





UGANDA (CONTINUED)

This year was an exciting time for our <u>primary school</u>, we had our first graduating class! We have been adding one class level at a time since 2013, and this year our primary 7 students sat for their exams and graduated to secondary school. Thanks to your support, this school not only provides an excellent education, but is a safe and fun space for these kids to be together. They all love spending their free time playing on their new playground that was installed this year!

This year we added a new section to our primary campus with the construction of our <u>nursery school</u> for kids ages 3-5. These buildings are custom designed to fit their needs, with plenty of space for learning centers, crafts and group activities. Our hope is that this school will equip these young students with the foundational learning skills that they need to be confident in school and enjoy learning. This school will officially open at the start of the new school year in February 2020!

We were excited to begin an education program in the women's prison in Gulu this year. We have Functional Adult Literacy and vocational skills programs for these women so that they can learn valuable tools for integration back into the community upon their release. We continue to be amazed by the joy and resilience of these women!





SOMALIA

2019 OVERVIEW



This year we were very excited to begin the construction of our new Girls Leadership Academy in Mogadishu. This academy will open its doors in 2020 to 200 girls between the ages of 12-18. In addition to traditional educational programs, the school will have a special focus on peace building and entrepreneurship. We will create programs for our students to run small businesses - these could be restaurants and cafes, salons, or electronic repair shops to name a few ideas. Each of these businesses will serve a need in the community, empower young women, and bring in funding for our school operations. We aim to grow this model until our school is financially self-sustainable! Our hope is that this academy will help develop confident young women and give them opportunities to learn, grow and be empowered to lead their communities. We cannot wait to cheer these girls on in all they do!
